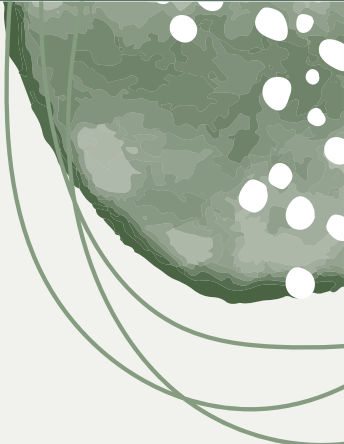

15. To reduce the community's reliance on a single source of income by diversifying the local economy through the development of various industries and business sectors.

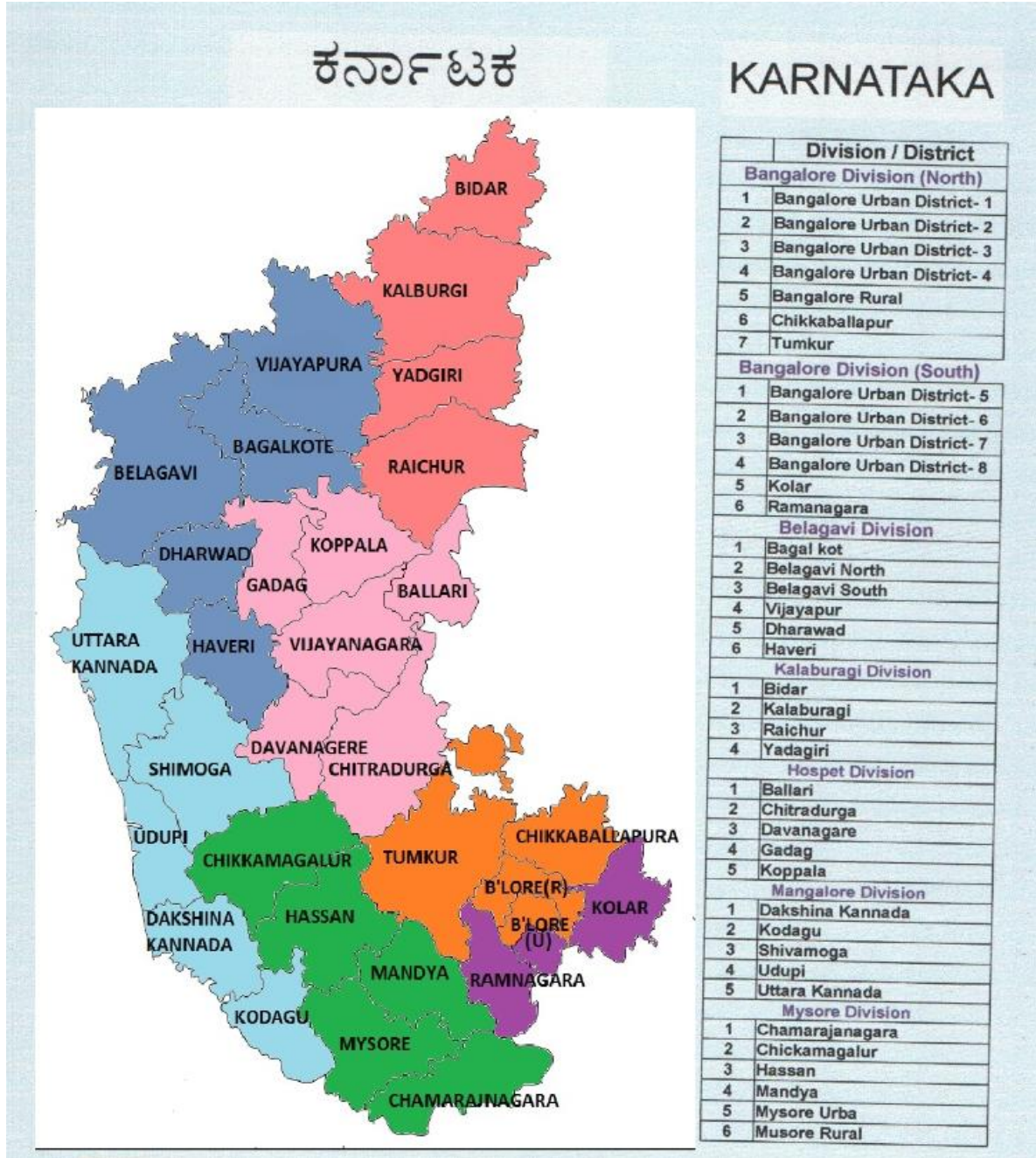

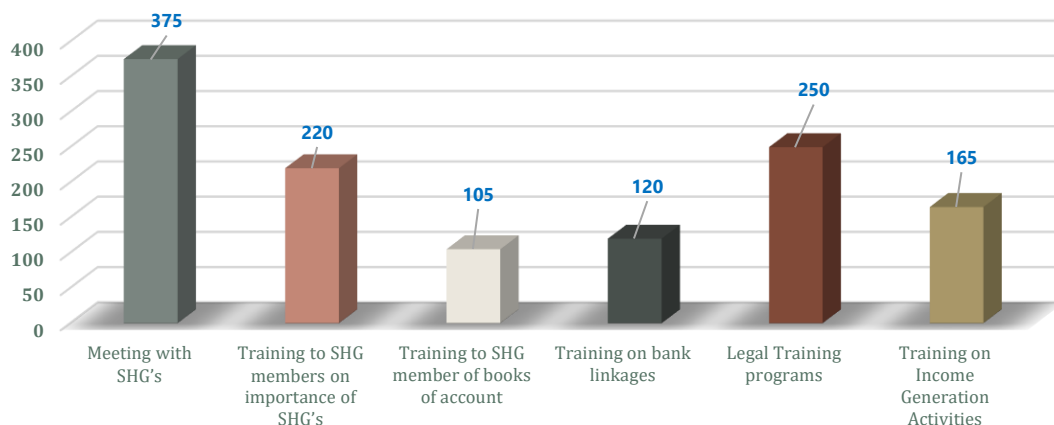

HALTH INTERVENTION

Health intervention programs are key programs conducted by Sri Kalpavruksha Urban & Rural Development Society ® Being a medical actioner by profession, the trustees have paid their significant contribution in extending their handholding support and service to most marginalized sections in the society who are deprived health services. Considering and leveraging the significance of Sustainable development Goal (SDG's), by SRI. KALPARUKSHA YOUTH, URBAN & RURAL DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY ® inevitably working towards achieving the good health and wellbeing of marginalized communities who are not in position to afford and get proper treatment.

HIV/AIDS INTERVNETION

India has 2.1 million people, the third-largest population living with HIV in the world, of whom, 56% adults are on treatment. While there is no cure for HIV, antiretroviral therapy can control the virus and decrease the transmission to other people. India has made gains in reducing new HIV infections by 27% and averting AIDS-related deaths by half since 2001. It's good progress but the work is far from done. In 2017, 69,000 people died from AIDS-related illness and 88,000 new cases of HIV infection were reported. The COVID-19 pandemic poses serious challenges and threatens the gains made in HIV and TB response in India. India's national HIV programme is working closely with the civil society, affected communities and state networks to develop guidelines and strategies to tackle the new challenges while ensuring uninterrupted HIV services to the key affected population.

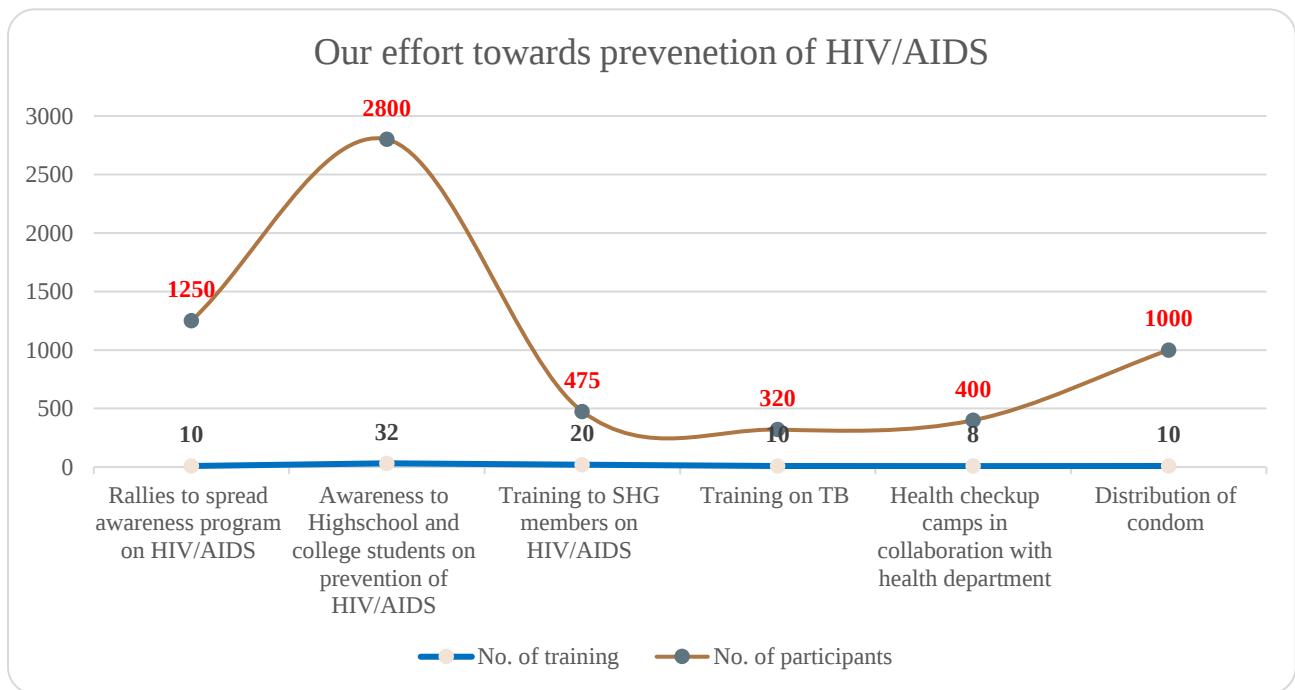

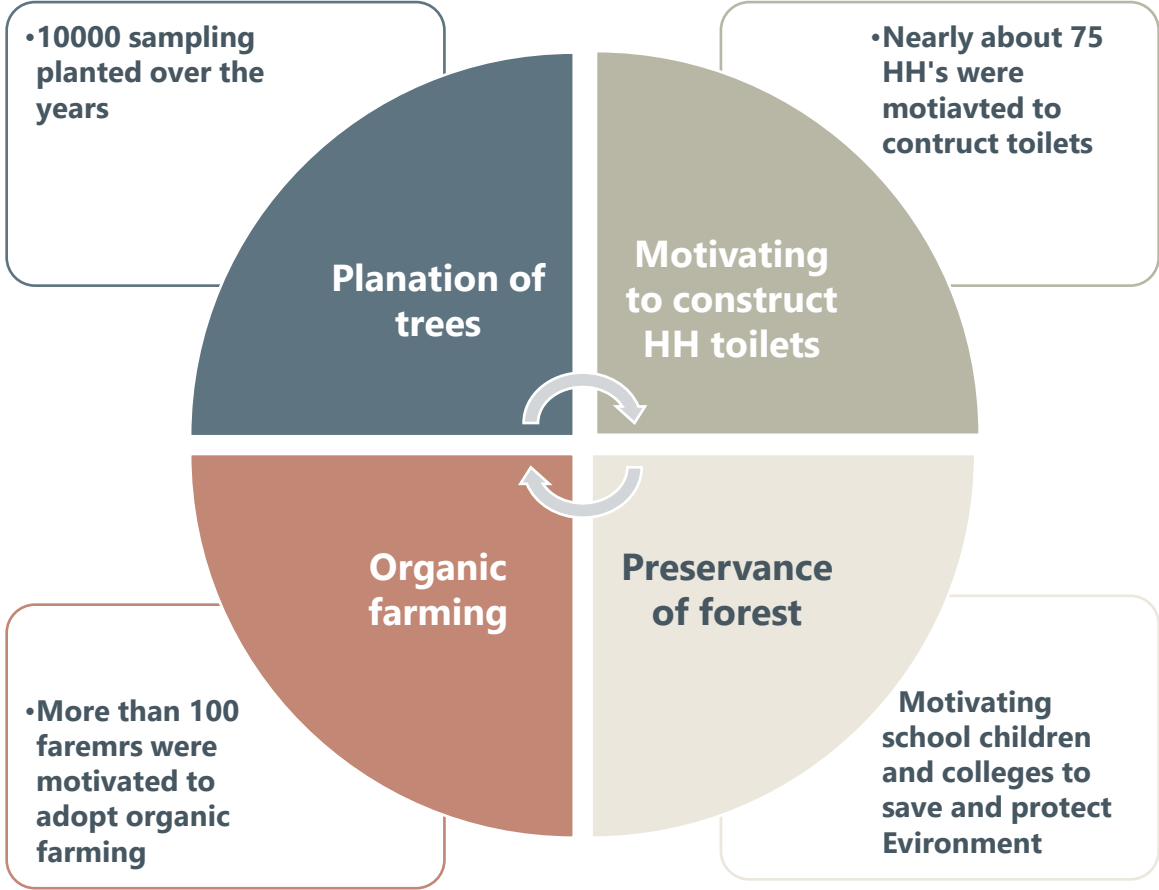
